Meeting Minutes from 10 April 2018

Two members, Bill Bruce and Cathy Kouchich and the Town Board representative Jan Bruce were present. Two guests were present.

The meeting started at 6 PM.

Jack and Kay Stutsman attended the meeting. They are planning to build a house at the corner of Wood Avenue and Sumner Street in Old Frontenac. They did not have plans to present, but were at the HPC to gather information regarding the administrative process for building a house. We also advised them that any questions regarding building codes should be directed to Goodhue County.
