

# **FLORENCE TOWNSHIP PARKS COMMISSION**

## **Minutes**

**July 6, 2021**

**Parks Commission Meeting was brought to order at 6:pm by Brent Urbach.**

**Commission members in attendance were Tom Johnson, Jane Webster-Urbach, Brent Urbach, Peggy Knudsen, Ted Tollefson and Mike Blair.**

**1.The Pledge of Allegiance was recited**

**2.” Be the Solution” a short reminder to residents to help fix the problems instead of complaining about them was read by Jane Webster-Urbach.**

**3.June 1<sup>st</sup> minutes were read and approved**

**Park Updates:**

**1.Wakondiota: Lynne and Dan Staker reported on the 900 mailings of the fund-raising letter. Donations have been arriving.**

**2.Swimming Beach and Boat Ramp: Brent Urbach is taking responsibility for the dock purchase. The \$10,000 donation from the Sportsmen’s Club can be used in 2022. Joe Ellingson reported the Club said “Get the best”. A sign saying “Absolutely no power loading” was recommended. Hok-Si-La manager told Jane “Less signage is better”. Use of permits to dock was discussed. Town Board will discuss that with Sportsmen’s Club.**

**4.Steamboat: . The 2007 Homeowner’s Assoc. agreement to take care of the Point and build a path will be discussed between Supervisor Joe Ellingson and HOA President Dave Amundson and will get info to township lawyer. A motion was made and seconded to create a parking area on North Steamboat. Another motion was made and passed to put 5-8 boulders for parking spots on North Steamboat. And another motion was made and seconded to get 2 trash cans for Steamboat.**

**5.Valhalla: Jane reported there will be spot spraying and mowing mid-July. A**

**walk-thru is scheduled for 7/20 at 4p.m.**

**6.Letters and other park correspondence- A letter was received by Nancy Eustis thanking the Park Board for all the work done on Valhalla Park. She is very pleased with the progress so far.**
