Narrative Description

This one-story house dating from ca. 1946 is located at the northeast corner of Dacotah Street and Wood Avenue. The complex L-plan has a gable- roofed main block. The building rests on an elevated concrete foundation. The roof is clad in composite shingles. There is a concrete block end-wall chimney on the south elevation. The main entry is accessed by concrete steps and has a single-leaf door. Windows include double-hung and sliding casement units. The building exterior is clad in asbestos shake siding. There is a small gable-roofed shed at the rear.

History

No information about the builder or early occupants was identified in local archives.

Statement of Significance

Included within the boundaries of the Old Frontenac Historic District as listed in the National Register of Historic Properties (NRHP) in 1973 (Lutz 1973), this building is associated with summer home development that continued to the Post-World-War-II period. It retains enough integrity to convey its significance as a contributing building within the district.
