#### **Narrative Description**

This house faces west on Westervelt Avenue Way W., south of County Road 2 Boulevard. The original rectangular plan, one-story, gable-roofed building has had many additions. It rests on a concrete foundation and the roof is clad in composite shingles. The main elevation has a central entry set in a projecting portico with a single-leaf door flanked by sidelights. There is a bay window at the north elevation and other windows include double-hung. The addition at the rear of the house dates from 2002 (Goodhue Co. Assessor).

There is an attached gable-roofed, single-car garage to the north of the house that may date from ca. 1951 (Goodhue Co. Assessor). The roof is clad in composite shingles and the exterior in vinyl.

#### **History**

Except for the prominently sited Christ Episcopal Church (1868), there was little development along Westervelt Avenue until after ca. 1940. This house was built during a period when only a few recreational properties were added to the townsite and after most residential, development was complete. The builder has not been identified and the site history has not been determined.

#### Significance

Included within the boundaries of the Old Frontenac Historic District as listed in the National Register of Historic Properties (NRHP) in 1973 (Lutz 1973), this building appears to be associated with the summer home development that continued through the World-War-II period. However, it is outside the period of significance for recreational properties described in the Old Frontenac Historic District context, "Tourism and Summer Home Development and the 'Lure of Old Frontenac,' 1868-1950" (Zellie and Lucas 2022). Therefore, it is not contributing to the historic district.
