Mike McKay from Wacouta Township and Lake Pepin Legacy Alliance gave a short presentation on what needs to be done to try to improve the water quality of Lake Pepin.

Old Business-The trees that were blocking the road on Van Blarcum have been trimmed. The roads are rough and there are a lot of potholes especially close to the intersections. Dale Messenberg says the community center lot could use some work. Ski road is done and it looks good. The Frontenac Station neighborhood watch meeting had over a dozen people present. We

are not sure when the next meeting will be. Ben Boege will call Luke Wurst to have him help clean up the minimum maintenance road.

New Business-The dumpsters at the community center need to be moved and some gravel put under them. Joe will call the Goodhue County waste management to see if they can move the dumpsters.

The Town Board is assigning replacement values of \$200,000.00 to the community center and the Town Hall for insurance purposes. A motion was made and second to approve the resolution to the insurance company valuing the community center and the Town Hall at \$200,000.00. The motion passed.
