Florence Township Regular Monthly Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:00. The clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. There was a motion made and second to approve as read. The motion passed. The treasure's report is as follows: A beginning balance in checking and money market account of \$130,121.56, receipts of \$440.60, disbursements of \$18,591.70 for a checking and money market balance \$111,970.46. We have four CD's for \$152,900.20 for a total cash and investments of \$264,870.66. A motion was made and second to approve as presented. The motion passed.

Zoning-Mike Zorn build 64x48' shed on 33455 Hill Avenue. He has planning commission approval. A motion was made and second to approve. The motion passed.

Tim Jonas-30016 Caledonia Avenue. Variance for a new septic system. Joe made a motion to approve. Jim second the motion. The motion passed.

Planning Commission- There are many non-conforming right of ways in the Township and therefore all are not treated the same. We thought Jim Reitter was going to attend our last meeting to discuss the right of way by his house but he did not attend the meeting.

Heritage Preservation Commission- We need members desperately. Bill Bruce will get the inventory on the signs. Mike has received bids for the roof using cedar shingles and regular shingles. The bids will be presented at the next HPC meeting. We received a reprimand from the state about the annual report. They are looking at our Certified Local Government status.

Parks Commission-We are going to get bid on the shelter at Wakiondiota Park and hopefully fix it up. We are putting our park commission activity on the website. We would like to recommend that the board approve the design for Valhalla Park. Joe made a motion to approve the McGhee and Betts park design for Valhalla Park. Jim second the motion. The motion passed. Our next step is how to

implement the design. The historical society would like to host an old time baseball game at Wakiondiota.

Friends of the Town Hall- Our next history fair will be October 11th 2014. The highway gardens need help keeping them up.

Old business- Brush dump- people are still dumping things that should not be dumped. It will be open the last Saturday of the month 9:00 to 12:00. We will check into a sign to list the days and times it will be open.

Roads- We will start putting rock on the roads this week weather permitting. We started trimming some trees today. Territorial Bridge bid has been approved.

No update on the steamboat landing.

The bathroom has been repaired. The A-1 cleaning company has given us a bid for cleaning the basement. We are getting water in the foundation from where the rain runs off. This needs to be addressed.

New Business-Election judge list approved.

All outstanding bills were paid
