Planning Commission-The minimum maintenance road had some work done on it by Goodhue County coop. Only one website presenter attended the last meeting. So our decision will be made until next month.

Heritage Commission – We have received two bids for painting and one for steel siding.

maintenance road. Joe made a motion to table it until next month. Jim second the motion. The motion passed.
