Larry Marshman-Improvements on his porch. He wants to extend the roof out over the deck. He will have to put in frost footings. The board recommends that he go to the County to find out what they would need for approval.

We are asking for Board approval of the sign ordinance tonight. Joe made a motion to approve the new sign ordinance and the new permit fee for signs. Mike second the motion. The motion passed.
