

HPC minutes from October 13, 2020

Meeting was called to order at 6pm

Members Cathy Kouchich & Todd Avery were present as well as 3 guests and 1 guest via tele-conference.

Minutes from the Sept meeting were read and approved.

New Business was conducted first

1. Katie Hardyman and Kirby Riegleman presented their plan for constructing an outdoor amphitheater at Christ Church. The HPC approved of the plans as they did not involve the structure of the historic building of the church and did not interfere with the gravesites present on the property.

2. It was also noted that new limestones from the Methodist church camp site were placed around the Westervelt gravesites at Christ Church.

3. The webpage for the 160th event has now expired so it will no longer be accessible on the township website. We noted that the www.frontenactour.com website is not in the township website. We will inform Jody to please add it the homepage.

Old Business:

1. We again discussed uses for the available COVID monies and strongly felt that it would be very suited to creating a hot spot within the community and or introducing more fiberoptic lines into the community. This would add much benefit for families who are now home schooling or working remotely from their homes or businesses.

2. The discussion continued regarding the updating of the historic boundary lines. Through discussion with SHPO it was revealed that the process would involve needing a grant, either a Legacy grant or a CLG grant, to hire a consultant to update the national register forms of the proposed boundaries including the Villa property and the north end of Lake Ave Way. The HPC would like to pursue this process.
